

MICROBLADING

PRE-PROCEDURE INFORMATION

Pain: There can be pain during and after the treatment. We recommend applying our topical numbing cream 30 minutes before your appointment to minimize the pain.

Infection: Infection is very rare. The areas treated must be kept clean and only freshly cleaned hands should touch the areas.

Allergic Reaction: There is a small possibility of an allergic reaction. The alternative is to not undergo this treatment, but use cosmetics instead.

Uneven Pigmentation: This can result from poor healing, oily skin, infection, bleeding, or other causes. Your 30-day Perfection appointment will likely correct any unevenness.

Asymmetry: Every effort will be made to avoid asymmetry but our faces are not symmetrical so adjustments may be needed at the 30-day Perfection appointment.

Excessive swelling or bruising: Some people bruise and swell more than others. Ice packs may help and bruising/swelling typically disappears within 1-5 days.

Anesthetics: Topical anesthetics are used to numb the treatment area. We sell a topical gel that contains 20% Benzocaine, 10% Lidocaine, and 10% Tetracaine. Do not use if allergic to any "caine" products. We do offer Pronox gas for an additional charge.

MRI: If you are scheduled for an MRI, you must inform your MRI technician that you have permanent eyebrows or any other tattoos. Because the pigments used in permanent treatments contain inert oxides, a low-level magnet may be necessary for your MRI scan.

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POST-PROCEDURE INFORMATION

FOLLOW-UP: Schedule your 30-day Perfection appointment after your Foundation appointment. This appointment is very important to keep because it's where hair strokes are added to your brows. There is a fee associated with this appointment.

SIDE EFFECTS: Mild swelling, itching, light scabbing, light bruising, and dry tightness can be expected.

COLOR: You will notice that your brown will have a dark and slightly uneven appearance for the first 3-5 days. After 5-7 days, the darkness will fade, and once any swelling is gone, the unevenness usually disappears. If it's still too dark or uneven, after 30 days, then we will make the appropriate corrections at your 30-day Perfection appointment. If you decide to go darker, this may require repeating the entire procedure and a fee may be required.

As the treated area heals, the color will lighten and sometimes seem to disappear in places. This will be addressed at your 30-day Perfection appointment. The treated area has to be completely healed before any adjustments can be made. No sooner than 30 days.

MAINTENANCE: Not all results are the same. To keep your brows looking fresh and beautiful, you need to schedule a touch-up treatment in 6 months. If you do not get the required 6-month touch-up, an additional fee may be required.
